Contact the church office for the quick, easy instructions to send securities to the church's account where they are converted to cash.
- ☐ I'm over 73 - Please contact me about the possibility of making gifts from my required IRA distributions and avoiding related taxes. In late 2022, Congress passed legislation that raised the age you have to start taking RMDs from 72 to 73 years old starting in 2023. This means that if you turned 72 in 2022, you'll need to take your first RMD by April 1, 2023 and will need to make another one by the end of 2023. If you turn 72 in 2023, you won't have to take an RMD until 2024 (when you turn 73), which will be due by April 1, 2025.
